I also give *The BEAT* the authority to call emergency medical personnel in the event of a medical emergency involving my child(ren), and authorize the medical personnel to perform the medical treatments that they determine to be necessary. Furthermore, I grant permission to the emergency medical personnel to transport the child(ren) to the nearest and accepting medical facility as they determine.

Rider Code of Conduct

Riders of *The BEAT* agree to respect passengers, employees, and property of *The BEAT*.
Riders, who verbally or physically taunt, abuse or otherwise harass passengers or employees of *The BEAT* or damage property of said persons, will be subject to removal from the vehicle, with or without warning, at the sole discretion of the vehicle driver or the management of Sharp Community Resources, Ltd.
The BEAT also reserves the right to require a shirt, pants and shoes to be worn in a manner that would not violate community decency standards.
Repeated violations of the Rider Code of Conduct will, at the discretion of the management of Sharp Community Resources, result in permanent expulsion from use of *The BEAT*. No refunds of previously paid passes will be given in the event of permanent expulsion.
The BEAT is not responsible for any damages that might arise from the removal of a violator of the Rider Code of Conduct. Additionally, remedies available to *The BEAT* do not exclude summoning of law enforcement personnel.
